

Spartan Stampede FAQ

Are spectators allowed to bring dogs or other pets?

Spectators are not allowed to bring any pets, except for certified service animals.

How long should we expect each performance to last?

Each performance lasts approximately 2 hours.

What events are at each performance?

Each performance we have bareback bronc riding, saddle bronc riding, steer wrestling, tie-down roping, barrel racing, team roping, and bull riding.

Is there reserved seating or is it general admission?

There are two seating levels available – ringside seating and upper level seating. Both sections are general admission, however you must have a ticket specific to that section.

Is it going to be cold in the Pavilion?

The rodeo is completely indoors, and the MSU Pavilion is heated.

When can we get into the arena area to take our seats?

Gates to seating open 1 hour before the performance. We encourage you to use your extra time to visit our many vendors.

Are there things to buy at the rodeo?

Yes! We bring in many vendors that sell a variety of items from clothing to art to food, and more. There is also a tent in the grand stands area where rodeo souvenirs can be purchased.

Is there handicapped seating available?

Handicapped seating is available. We will do our best to accommodate family members to sit in that area as well, however space is limited.

Where can I park?

Parking is available in the two paved lots to the north of the pavilion, as well as the paved lot to the west of the pavilion.

What is the address of the MSU Pavilion?

What if I didn't buy my tickets in advance?

Some tickets will be available for purchase at the door the day of the event, but we encourage you to buy tickets in advance as we have previously sold out all 4 performances.

What is ticket pricing for kids?

Children 2 & under get in free

What are the ticket prices for the rodeo?

In advance, ringside tickets are \$20 and upper seating tickets are \$12. Beginning the Friday of the first performance, ringside tickets are \$20 and upper seating tickets are \$15.

Are there any discounted tickets available?

Discounted tickets are only available when purchased in advance and are handled directly through the Wharton Center. All upper level seating is \$12 when purchased in advance. Student discount (valid MSU ID required) and military discount tickets are available for upper level seating only at \$10/ticket. No discounts are available for ringside seating.

How do I compete in the rodeo?

www.ipra-rodeo.com/schedule offers entry information for each rodeo. Call-ins for entries occur approximately a week before the rodeo. When you enter the rodeo, you will only compete in 1 of 4 performances due to the volume of contestants. Event winners are determined once all 4 performances have been completed.

Is there food available on site?

MSU Concessions will be open and selling food. We also typically have at least a couple of vendors selling snack items.

Is the rodeo ever cancelled?

No. The show will go on whether rain, snow, sleet, or shine!
