Disclaimers

- ❖ Entries must be mailed in together in the **SAME ENVELOPE** to be stalled together
- ❖ Entrance into the pavilion will not be allowed until 11:30am Thursday
- ❖ Entries/Check-in will be open from 11:30am – 3:30pm the day of the show
- ❖ Stalls will remain locked until proof of a current, negative coggins is shown
- ❖ All money must accompany entries
- ❖ Absolutely no refunds without proof from a veterinarian or doctor
- ❖ No trading or buying another person's draw spot
- ❖ All riders must include a waiver with their entry (see the bottom of this sheet)
- ❖ If time allows, we will have open arena before poles. There is a guaranteed warm up time before youth barrels and before open barrels
- ❖ The order of events will be open poles, youth barrels, and open barrels
- ❖ All payouts will be in the form of check
- ❖ Weekend stalls are available only for rodeo contestants. Jackpot only contestants must be out of their stalls by 9:30am Friday
- ❖ 1 horse per stall whether loose or tied, no horses tied in alleyways or kept in rodeo stock back pens, no horses tied to locked stalls
- ❖ Dogs must be on leashes
- ❖ Western attire is required (long sleeve collared shirt, jeans, boots, and a cowboy hat or helmet)
- ❖ Expos will be limited to 2 per horse and rider combo and we will stop taking money for expos at 2:00 (we want to start the show on time!)
- ❖ We will drag after every 12 riders as marked on the draw (if someone in that group of 12 scratches, we will still keep the drag order the same)
- ❖ Late entries will be added to the bottom of the draw
- ❖ Stalls are not required, but there is very limited space to tie around the warm up pen
- ❖ There will be a \$30 fee for all returned checks
- ❖ Re-runs will only be given for timer malfunctions
- ❖ There will be a 30 second time limit on all expo runs
